Did you know?

- This past year over 46,000 emergency room patients were treated which included more than 8,000 children - - over 94% of these patients were treated and discharged home.
- Our Ambulatory Care Clinic has an annual average of 21,418 visits per year - Including Emergency Transition Clinic, Orthopedics, Geriatrics, Neurology, ENT, Pediatrics, Infectious Disease, Surgery, Women's Colposcopy, and IV Therapy.
- Over 40,764 visits annually with Diagnostic Imaging services - including CT, ultrasound and x-ray The on-site lab sees an average of 51,849 individuals annually.
- In 2021, with support of our donors and community, Strathcona Community Hospital Foundation invested over \$189,000 in funding to Strathcona Community Hospital to accelerate healthcare in our community.

STCH IV Therapy Renovation



- 9990 IV Therapy treatments were completed in 2021 at Strathcona Community Hospital in a space designated as temporary. This number of treatments is growing annual and forecasted for continual growth
- 7 days a week - 7:30 am to 10:15 pm
- 9990 patients were seen in 2021
- Antibiotic and non-antibiotic therapy patients
 - Short or long-term antibiotics
 - Blood transfusions, LP IVIG
 - Edaravone treatment for ALS patients
 - Saline bolus doses - hyperemesis with pregnancy or any other condition that may need regular fluid if they have difficulty with absorption or malabsorption issues with the gut
- When Emergency explodes, IV Therapy explodes
- Increased capacity of the Ambulatory Care Clinic and Emergency
- Prescribed IV Therapy is a growing treatment by physicians onsite and in the community for varying needs
- IV Therapy treatments last approximately 60 minutes and the patient must remain stationary during the process and remain on site
- Strathcona Community Hospital Foundation has committed to raise \$250,000 of community and corporate funding towards this \$1.4 million dollar project
- Construction to begin January 2023 with project completion scheduled for 2023
